## MONTHLY 2-TIME WAGE PAYMENT FOR WORKERS/EMPLOYEES

The Ministry of Labor and Vocational Training would like to publicly announce that factories/enterprises have previously paid monthly wages to their respective workers/employees between the 01<sup>st</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> of the upcoming month as factories/enterprises have to do overtime, produced products and other incentive calculation in each month. However, from January 2019, factories/enterprises shall pay 50% of the wage to workers/employees between 16<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of each month, and shall pay the remaining wage to workers/factories between 01<sup>st</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> of the coming month.

As of the afternoon on 16 January 2019, MoLVT followed up the practice of the monthly 2-time wage payment for workers/employees, finding that 81% of factories/enterprises have been following the practice in compliance with the Prakas No. 442 in which:

1-Some 50% of factories/enterprises in the sector of textile, garment and footwear followed the first wage payment between 16<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of this January, while the second payment falls between the 01<sup>st</sup> and 07<sup>th</sup> of the upcoming month.

2-Some 25% of factories/enterprises in the sector of textile, garment and footwear followed the first wage payment on 16<sup>th</sup> of this January, while the second payment falls on the 01<sup>st</sup> of the upcoming month.

3- Some 25% of factories/enterprises in the sector of textile, garment and footwear followed the first wage payment on 25<sup>th</sup> January, while the second falls on 10<sup>th</sup> of the upcoming month.

The ministry will inspect factories/enterprises under the practice preparation. In case they fail to follow, they shall be punished accordingly.

As having informed above, may it be heard publicly.
